



MULTIPLE PAYMENT TITLE LOANS

This product requires multiple CAB Fee payments with a single payment of principal and interest to lender.

FEE SCHEDULE DISCLOSURE: TEXAS

FINANCE CHARGES: For the Credit Access Business ("CAB") fee you will pay a standard rate of \$25 every calculation period per \$100 (monthly) on loans up to \$2,000; \$17 every calculation period per \$100 (monthly) on loans from \$2001 to \$3,000; and \$15 every calculation period per \$100 (monthly) on loans from \$3,001 to \$25,000. You will make a single payment of principal, final CAB fee, and 10% interest on the maturity date. The following examples demonstrate how finance charges are imposed on loans.

IN THE EXAMPLES, CAB FEES ARE DUE ON PAYMENTS 1-4, AND THE THIRD-PARTY LENDER INTEREST, PRINCIPAL AND THE FINAL CAB FEE ARE DUE ON THE MATURITY DATE. CUSTOMERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO PAY MORE THAN THE MINIMUM PAYMENT TO REDUCE FINANCE CHARGES.

* Loan term varies based on income dates.

** **Annual Percentage Rate:** The APR is the cost of your loan expressed as a yearly rate. The APR will increase if the actual loan term is shorter than this example, and will decrease if your loan term is longer.

Motor Vehicle: In the event of default, the consumer may be required to surrender possession of the motor vehicle to the lender or other person to satisfy the consumer's outstanding obligations under the loan.

Returned Item Charge: If you make a payment and your payment is returned for any reason, you will be charged \$30 fee each time.

License: This business is licensed and examined under Texas law by the Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner ("OCCC"), a state agency.
